HOCKEY OPERATION UPDATES

LEAGUESTATS:

- Logins: All ACHA Teams were issued 2 unique logins for the LeagueStat system once they declared their team. The emails would have come from "LeagueStat," one for the TEAM REP and one for your SCOREKEEPER. Teams that feel they did not receive the login emails, should reach out to Craig Barnett at cbarnett@achahockey.org Instructions and easy to understand User Guides can be found on ACHA website by going to HOME > RESOURCES > OPERATIONS INFO > LEAGUESTATS
- Scoring Games: All games should be scored by the HOME TEAM. There are 2 ways to score a game (1) live during the game or post-game before 12 midnight local time the day of the game by using the Scorekeeper login. (2) day after a game by using your Team Rep login (separate instructions in LeagueStat Resources on website). All games need to be scored by the deadline published in your divisional operation policies.
- Schedule Uploads and Changes: All Home Schedules should be emailed to your respective ACHA Commissioner and Craig Barnett to be uploaded into the LeagueStat system. Any changes to your schedule should be emailed to the same people.

ROSTERS:

- Rosters are developed by using the USAH Registration portal. Your Team Rep should have received a link to send to your players so they can register with USAH. Your Team Rep would then claim your players to submit into the Registration portal for approval.
