



Tragically, we recently lost 3 young men and the ACHA would like to offer our condolences to the King, Klekotka and McEwen families, friends, and teammates. California University of Pennsylvania Vulcans defenseman **Branson King** passed away unexpectedly on December 11, 2021. He was 23 years old. Aquinas College Saints captain **Alex Klekotka** passed away on December 18, 2021. He was also 23 years old and the Wolverine Hoosier Athletic Conference Player of the Year last season. The ACHA also acknowledges the devastation of the tornadoes that hit the Midwest last month which took the life of recent McKendree University Bearcat defenseman **Austin McEwen** on December 10, 2021. He was 26 years old and played for the Bearcats from 2013-15. Our membership continues to send thoughts and prayers to their families.
